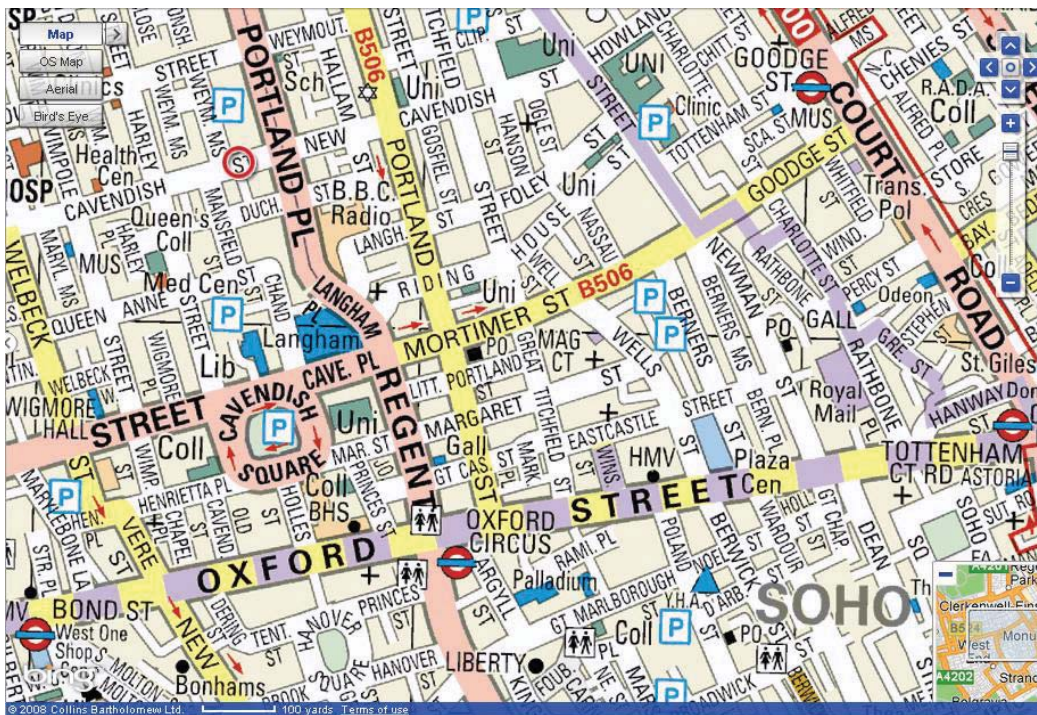

By Rail

Marylebone, Euston and Kings Cross St Pancras Stations are all within a 10 minutes taxi ride or alternatively 15 minutes by Underground. Paddington Station (which has a direct link to Heathrow every 15 minutes) is 10 minutes in a taxi.

By Underground

Oxford Circus Underground Station is 5 minutes walk away. Take Exit 4 on leaving the station, walk North up Regent Street, past the Langham Hotel. Duchess Street is the 5th on the left. Turn left, and almost immediately you will see Duchess Mews on your right hand side, where our sign is clearly displayed.

Car Parking

On street Pay and Display car parking is available outside the Conference Centre, otherwise there are NCP car parks, all within 5 minutes walk of the venue.
